

Timeless treasures




Wine has a soul. It needs love, care and also a few small secrets. One of the secrets at Cantina Terzano is the Wine Archive, an extensive collection including more than 90 vintages. About 13 meters underground, it contains some 100,000 wines of every vintage from 1955 to the present plus a few that are even older.



Extraordinary terroir


It has long been known that the terroir of Terzano reflects a prehistorical secret. Geological investigation have now provided scientific data to confirm the presence of a subvolcanic body with a unique crystal cuvée: good grounds for the outstanding longevity of Terzano wines.

Crystal deposits in the rock, with conversion of the minerals and recrystallization, which promotes ion exchange and strengthens the supply of nutrients.




White wines

Nova Domus Terlaner Cuvée Riserva

A noble blend of Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, named after Terlan's famed Neuhaus Castle. It displays a wide range of aromas, an intriguing acidity and harmonious full-bodied flavor.

Quarz Sauvignon

As clear as the quartz crystals in the porphyry soil of Terlan, this voluminous Sauvignon Blanc presents a complex bouquet and an extremely minerally and long lingering finish.

Lunare Gewürztraminer

The name for this select white wine was taken from the fresco of the Madonna Seated on a Crescent Moon, which can be seen in the parish church of Terlan. It has a soft, full-bodied and harmonious structure topped off by pleasantly spicy Termeno aromas.

Vorberg Pinot Bianco Riserva

This complex Pinot Blanc boasts a pleasant acidity and a long minerally, salty finish. It is a convincing combination of elegance and outstanding longevity.

Kreuth Chardonnay

This distinctive Terlan Chardonnay has a rich and ripe aroma and a body that is typical of this variety.

Winkl Sauvignon

This delicate Sauvignon Blanc has been vinified at Terlan since 1956 and is characterized by an intense fruitiness, with balanced acidity and a dense structure.

Terlaner Cuvée

Our historical cuvée, which has been made from Terlan's three traditional grape varieties Pinot Bianco, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc for the last 120 years, is a wine of great complexity.

Premium quality wines from the Terlan DOC area. Vinification of the selected grapes in oak barrels and stainless steel casks yields wines with great complexity and longevity.

Porphyre

Lagrein

The wine is named after the volcanic bedrock of the soil in which our oldest vines are cultivated. It is characterized by a distinct berry aroma, full, satiny and very long-lasting flavor and a pronounced structure.

Gries

Lagrein Riserva

This indigenous red variety is a succulent wine with soft tannins and a predominant fruitiness.

Monticol

Pinot Noir Riserva

This elegant Pinot Noir combines complex berry notes with a harmonious and lively acidity.

Siebeneich

Merlot Riserva

This complex Merlot with its ripe fruit flavors is an exciting wine with a multifaceted bouquet and a long finish.
